Rise kindly requests \$20,000 in funding to continue Aging Families Understanding Nutrition, AFUN, a senior feeding program that delivers all the necessary ingredients to cook a healthy meal, nutritional tips, and social support through volunteers' phone calls.

• **Has the identified problem changed?**

The need for healthy nutritional guidance and social connections among low-income seniors has remained unchanged.

• **Have your solution or goals changed?**

To increase convenience and ensure a smoother process, the program director and volunteer team developed a solution for prepackaging and delivering the food boxes while allowing in-person pick-up and interactions for those who prefer it.

• **Will your efforts/actions to impact the problem change? Describe.**

Despite the challenges, our efforts to address the problem of elderly food insecurity will remain steadfast as this project has raised awareness and established a dedicated group of volunteers who value the interactions with the seniors and enjoy witnessing them incorporate a more healthy lifestyle.



• Are there changes in funding or program implementation partners?

As we continue to work more closely with housing authorities, individuals, and nutritionists, our relationship with program partners has deepened and become more meaningful.

• How will you know if your actions are having an impact?

We are confident that our program is making a positive impact, as evidenced by the relationships built with participants, feedback from surveys and recipe critiques, and frequent updates on their health status.
