Project title: Chair Yoga 4 Seniors in two new centers

Summary Description (maximum 25 words):

Empowering older adults with accessible chair yoga and micro-movements to improve physical vitality, emotional well-being, and social connection through data-informed, trauma-informed programming.

1. What is the problem you have identified?

Older adults often face limited mobility, chronic pain, emotional distress, and social isolation, yet lack access to low-barrier wellness practices that promote holistic health. Traditional activities are often inaccessible or overly institutional, especially for individuals outside of formal facilities.

2. What is the solution you propose to address the problem?

We propose weekly trauma-informed chair yoga and micro-movement classes tailored to elders' physical and emotional needs. By meeting them where they are, both physically and emotionally, we aim to deliver inclusive wellness services that improve quality of life and foster connection, supported by simple self-assessment tools to measure impact.

3. What actions will you take?

- Deliver weekly in-person and virtual classes at senior centers and community hubs.
- Train instructors in equity-aligned, age-sensitive care.
- Collect participant wellness data before, during, and after the program.
- Invite personal reflections to elevate elder voices.
- Analyze outcomes to inform programming and advocacy for wider adoption.

4. Describe the population to be served.

We will serve approximately 50 new older adults aged 62–90 across Philadelphia, including those living independently, in personal care, rehab, or with disabilities or dementia. The program is especially focused on elders in underserved communities seeking connection, movement, and accessible care.

5. Are there partners/collaborators for implementation or funding-who? Has the solution been tried by other organizations?

We partner with senior facilities throughout Philadelphia for implementation. While chair yoga is practiced in some elder care settings, few organizations document its impact. Our innovation lies in combining movement with intentional data collection, storytelling, and inclusive design to build a scalable, evidence-based model of elder wellness.

6. How will you know your actions are having an impact? How will you measure outputs and outcomes?


Impact will be measured using a self-administered health and happiness scale, drawn from the Stanford Geriatric Depression Scale and Yoga 4 The World's custom survey. Outputs include the number of classes delivered and participants engaged. Outcomes include improved emotional well-being, mobility confidence, and reduced isolation, which is tracked through surveys and participant testimonials.
